### Day 1, Wednesday

This morning we travel through picturesque southwestern Wisconsin en route to historic **Galena, IL**. Upon arrival, we tour the **Ulysses S. Grant Home** which has been restored to its post-Civil War era splendor. Next we have **free time** to explore and have lunch on our own in the **downtown area**. There are over 100 shops within a six block area including the Great American Popcorn Company which produces over 150 flavors of popcorn. Before checking in to our hotel, we stop at **Blaum Bros. Distilling Company** for a **tour and tasting**. From the distillation area, to the barrel room, to the comfortable tasting room and cocktail bar, we will see the entire process of how their spirits are handcrafted. **Dinner** is included tonight at **Frank O'Dowd's Irish Pub. ### Day 2, Thursday

Our morning begins with beautiful views and wonderful photo opportunities aboard the **Galena Trolley**. The "town that time forgot" will enchant you with its grand homes and buildings which are examples of the finest period architecture in the Midwest. Next we take a tour of **Galena Cellars Vineyard and Winery**. They are proud to offer more than 40 distinct award-winning varieties producing over 60,000 gallons of wine a year. This afternoon we travel the short distance to **Dubuque, IA**, where we take an entertaining and informative journey on the mighty Mississippi at the **National Mississippi River Museum and Aquarium** including a **show** at their on-site **4D Immersion Theater**. Our evening is reserved for a lovely **dinner cruise** aboard the **Spirit of Dubuque**, the area's only authentic paddlewheeler. **B, D**



### Day 3, Friday

Traveling north to Prairie du Chien, WI, we experience life during the 19th century while visiting **Villa Louis**, the estate of one of Wisconsin's most prosperous families, which has been restored to its 1890s grandeur. We arrive home by mid evening. **B**
