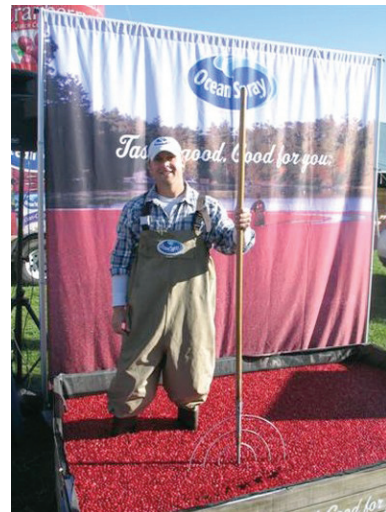
Join us for this day tour that has been one of our most popular for years: the **Annual Cranberry Festival** in the heart of cranberryland... **Warrens, Wisconsin!**
