### Day 1, Saturday

**Mall of America** is a great place to visit and shop year round. We make it easy for you during the busy holiday season. See and explore one of the country's top tourist attractions and the nation's largest retail and entertainment complex. Anchored by Marshall's, Macy's, Nordstrom and Sears, this 4.2 million square foot multi-level complex is home to more than 520 world-class shops and 50 restaurants and is Minnesota's #1 tourist attraction. Even though we'll be there as the cold season starts, it's always a beautiful 72° and sunny in the Mall. The amazing thing about this facility is that it has no central heating system. The entire mall is heated by solar passive energy, store lighting and fixtures and the body heat of the 40 million visitors the mall sees each year!

Along with fabulous shopping, the mall also offers some fantastic entertainment for all ages. You can visit Minnesota Sea Life Aquarium, a 1.2 million gallon walk-through aquarium that houses the largest number of sharks in captivity. There's

also Nickelodeon Universe, a fantastic indoor amusement park that features 27 rides and 3 retail stores. For the child in all of us, there's American Girl, Build-a-Bear Workshop and the LEGO Store. If you want to take a break from your day of shopping, there's also a 14-screen movie theater where you can catch the latest flick or maybe you want to take the shuttle service to the Mystic Lake Casino. (Some of these options have admission costs not included in your tour price.)

If spending 2 days at the Mall of America is too much of a good thing, for a small fee you can catch the Metro Transit's Light Rail at the Mall of America and travel to the Nicollet Mall in downtown Minneapolis for your first day's shopping adventure. Nicollet Mall is a 12-block pedestrian thoroughfare in the heart of downtown Minneapolis closed to all vehicular traffic except buses and taxis, making it the perfect place to stroll and leisurely partake in all this wonderful area has to offer. You can even take a break from shopping and visit "Restaurant

Row" for a warm drink and a hot meal before you pound the pavement again!

Our overnight accommodations are in Bloomington, MN, where you can enjoy the indoor pool, exercise room and adjacent restaurant. **Free shuttle service** between the hotel and mall is provided.

### Day 2, Sunday

After some time to relax and enjoy some of the amenities our hotel has to offer, we return to the Mall of America when they open to finish our holiday shopping before heading home. **B**
