Day 1, Wednesday

A local guide boards our coach this morning for a **City Tour of Omaha**, known for its rich pioneer history. **Lunch** is served at **Big Mama's Kitchen** – a Southern fixture with a lively feel dishing out signature versions of soul-food classics. Next we get to learn about the art of making fine instruments with a **Violin Making Presentation** at the Hot Shops Art Center.

Our afternoon is spent in **Boys**

Town where we get to **tour the village** that has been helping at-risk children for over 100 years. When Father Edward J. Flanagan purchased the Overlook Farm in 1921, it became the new, permanent site of Boys Town. Over the decades that followed, schools, churches and homes were built, and tens of thousands of young lives were transformed. After the tour we visit **Union Station** which houses **The Durham Museum**, a 1930's Train Station beautifully decorated for the holiday season. **B, L**

Day 3, Friday

Our morning is reserved for the **Poinsettia Garden Display** at the **Lauritzen Botanical Gardens** and the **Hollywood Candy Warehouse**, where we'll be transported back in time as we traverse through their retro

diner, Hollywood theater, antique mall, and aisles of old time and homemade candies. Afterward we enjoy "Christmas in Germany" with a delicious lunch and entertainment provided by the Men's Choir.

This evening, the Lord and Lady of Essex invite you to join them for feasting, music, and merriment at the **Christmas in Olde England Dinner Show**. At this unique and original form of "dinner theatre" we will return to the Renaissance years for a festive holiday evening at an old English Castle. **B, L, D**

Day 4, Saturday

Holiday décor represents the traditional holidays of the 1880s when we visit the **Victorian Christmas at the 1879 General Crook House**, followed by a unique **Gingerbread House Display** at Mormon Trails
