



RACINE CITY TOUR & KRINGLE EXPERIENCE

Today we travel to southeastern Wisconsin for the **Racine City Tour & Kringle Experience**. We start our morning with a stop at the **Wind Point Lighthouse**. Designed by Orlando Metcalf Poe, it was lit for the first time on November 15, 1880, and continues to be lit to this day. While here we will see a video of the history of the lighthouse, see the original Fresnel lens and will be treated to a **docent-guided tour** of the facility. **Please note:** We will NOT be climbing the tower of the lighthouse.



A **city tour of Racine** is next on our agenda for today. Our **step-on guide** will show us the highlights of the city and will focus on its rich Danish history, landmarks, and founders.

Our tour of Racine continues with a **lunch** stop at **Reefpoint Brew House**. Located by the shore of Lake Michigan with a view of the Marina, Reefpoint Brew House is a local favorite that is sure to please.

We continue with the final part of our tour...the kringles! We will stop at several **kringle shops** for a kringle making demonstration, samples, treats, and bakery shopping. **L**
