Day 1, Monday

A day of travel through Illinois and Indiana takes us toward our first destination — Music City, USA — Nashville, TN. We overnight in Clarksville, IN.

Day 2, Tuesday

Today we travel to **Nashville** with a stop at the **Nissan Assembly Plant** in Smyrna, TN, for a **narrated tour of the facility** with a capacity of 550,000 vehicles annually. After we check into our Nashville hotel for two nights, we enjoy the **Grand Ole Opry** which combines entertainment, comedy and music into one package. **B, D**

Day 3, Wednesday

This morning a **local guide** takes us on a **narrated tour of Nashville** which includes the historic **Ryman Auditorium**, original home of the Grand Ole Opry. Nearby is the \$40 million **Country Music Hall of Fame** with its incredible array of rare costumes, instruments and historical mementos. Tonight **dinner and entertainment** await us at the **Nashville Nightlife Theatre**. **B, D**

Day 4, Thursday

Our morning begins with a visit to **Loretta Lynn's Ranch** in Hurricane Mills, TN. We tour the 14-room plantation home, Coal Miner's Daughter Museum, a simulated coal mine and a replica of Butcher Holler Homeplace. This afternoon we travel to **Memphis, TN**, for a two-night stay. Following our check-in, **dinner** is included featuring Memphis cuisine and entertainment on **Beale Street**. **B, D**

Day 5, Friday

A **guided tour of Memphis** introduces us to the city's history, Mighty Mississippi views and unique culture. The highlight of any Memphis visit is **Graceland**, the home Elvis lived in and loved so much. Our **Elvis Experience Tour** includes the mansion, automobile



museum, and other exhibits showcasing his life and career. Tonight enjoy a return to Beale Street or visit the new Memphis Pyramid Bass Pro Shop. **B**

Day 6, Saturday

This morning before we depart Memphis we visit the **Pink Palace Museum** constructed of pink marble. The 1920s estate was built by entrepreneur Clarence Saunders, founder of the Piggly Wiggly stores. It now contains exhibits about Mississippi life through the 20th century. Our route continues on to the St. Louis, MO, area for tonight's lodging. **B**

Day 7, Sunday

With many pleasant memories of "sights and sounds," we return to our home destinations later this afternoon. **B**
