DAY 1, Sunday

Our first day takes us to our accommodations in Sioux Falls, SD.

DAY 2, Monday

In Mitchell, SD, we view the fascinating **Corn Palace** covered with designs made from ears of corn, local grasses and grains. Driving through **Badlands National Park**, we marvel at its splendor on our way to accommodations for two nights in Deadwood, SD. **B**



DAY 3, Tuesday

Today we tour the **Deadwood** area on board a local **trolley** with a driver narrating the area's history and sights. A stop at **Adams Museum** allows us to relive the pioneer life of Deadwood and the Black Hills. After the museum we will have **leisure time** for shopping and lunch. Next a guided tour of the **Homestead Gold Mine** introduces us to the famous Black Hills Gold Rush story.

Witness the assassination of Wild Bill Hickock during a **gunfight on Main Street** followed by **dinner** and the play, **The Trial of Jack McCall**. **B, D**

DAY 4, Wednesday

This morning a visit to **Tatanka Interpretive Center** tells the living history story of the bison with interactive displays. For **lunch**, we experience a unique adventure at the **Fish & Fry trout pond** — fishing for our own delicious lunch. (Chicken can

be substituted). A drive through **Bear Country USA** brings us close-up and personal to numerous animals in their natural habitat. Tonight we savor a **chuck wagon cowboy supper and show**. Our accommodations are in Rapid City, SD, for two nights. **B, L, D**

DAY 5, Thursday

Today we venture into the world of Gutzon Borglum, the sculptor of Mount Rushmore, at the **Borglum Historical Center** before we view **Mount Rushmore**, South Dakota's epic sculpture. Next we visit **Crazy Horse Memorial**, a colossal project to honor Chief Crazy Horse. **Dinner** is followed by the spectacular **lighting display of Mt. Rushmore**. **B, D**

DAY 6, Friday

On our way to Sioux Falls, SD, we stop at the famous **Wall Drug Store**. A **farewell dinner** is planned for us this evening. **B, D**

DAY 7, Saturday

The day is spent traveling home. **B**
