DAY 1, Thursday

A day of travel takes us closer to our destination: our nation's capital in Washington D.C. We check into our hotel in the Cleveland, OH, area.

DAY 2, Friday

DAY 4, Sunday

Our Washington D.C. visit continues with such poignant and inspirational sights as **Arlington Cemetery**, including the **Tomb of the Unknowns** and **Kennedy Graves**, as well as the **Iwo Jima Memorial**. We also stop at the **Smithsonian Museums**. **B, D**

DAY 5, Monday

Today we visit the new **Capitol Visitor's Center**. Finished in November of 2008, we will see a 13-minute orientation film and view artifacts, documents and exhibits prior to a **tour of the US Capitol Building**. Our next stop is the **Holocaust Memorial Museum**. The museum serves as a monument to those who suffered and

died at the hands of the Nazis during their rule of Germany. **B**

DAY 6, Tuesday

Our destination this morning is historic **Gettysburg, PA**. Upon arrival we will visit the **Museum and Visitor Center**. The film *A New Birth of Freedom* orients us to the significance of Gettysburg. Highlights include the massive **Battle of Gettysburg Cyclorama** and a **licensed guide** who will take us on a **coach tour of the battlefield**. This evening we enjoy **dinner** at the **Dobbin House Tavern**, originally a home built in 1776. **B, D**

DAY 7, Wednesday

Today we begin our journey home. It is hard to believe so many famous sights could be seen in just a few days. We will overnight in Fremont, OH. **Dinner** follows our arrival. **B, D**

DAY 8, Thursday
