course of its 80+ years of existence, the track has undergone its share of trials and triumphs including a fire in 1985 that totally destroyed the facility necessitating its reconstruction. In 2000 it merged with Church Hill Downs and continues to be a leader in the field. In 2007, Arlington Park became the first Midwest track to install a synthetic racing surface.

We have **reserved box seats** offering the best outdoor seating available with commanding views of the track under the shelter of the track’s world-famous cantilevered roof. A **daily racing guide** will help you select the winners and bets can be placed on the simulcast if you so choose. If you prefer not to wager, you can visit the paddock where the horses are saddled. An included **lunch** can be eaten at your seat while you watch the race and cheer on your favorite horses. **L**
